

## 2026 APPLICATIONS NOW OPEN

Kamoa Copper S.A. supports a facility of higher education, the Kamoa Centre of Excellence (KCE). The KCE is located between the Kamoa-Kakula operations and the town of Kolwezi, on the DRC Copperbelt.

The KCE is proud to announce the offering of bursaries to a select group of talented and promising students. These bursaries will support enrolment in a specialized one-year curriculum program developed in collaboration with Enterprises University of Pretoria and Sales Academy.

Classes are scheduled to begin on 1 September 2026 and will be conducted in person at the KCE facilities.



## Selection Process:

**Application Review:** Applications will be assessed and shortlisted based on established qualification criteria, with a particular emphasis on academic performance in mathematics, science, and English.

**Interviews:** Shortlisted candidates will be required to participate in either a telephone or in-person interview (Mid-May 2026).

**Admission Test:** Selected candidates from the interview stage will be required to take an in-person admission test, scheduled for Mid-June 2026 at the KCE.

**Scholarship Award Ceremony:** Successful candidates will be expected to attend an in-person scholarship award ceremony at KCE in July 2026.

The KCE curriculum program will commence on **1 September 2026** and conclude in **July 2027**.

**Attendance in person is mandatory for all classes;** virtual attendance is not permitted.

Only shortlisted applicants will be contacted for the next steps in the selection process. If you do not hear from us, please understand that you have not been shortlisted.

## Who can Apply

A total of **40 bursaries** will be awarded to the **top applicants** through a rigorous selection process.

- Candidates must have achieved a **minimum academic average of 60%**, as reflected in your Diplôme d'État (or Attestation de Réussite)\*.
- Applicants must be between **18 and 24 years** old
- Proficiency in **English communication, mathematics, science, and computer literacy** is required
- Applicants must hold **citizenship of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC)**

\* If you are currently in your 4th ème, you may submit your first semester average. However, you will still need to provide a final average above 60% before the course begins on September 1, 2026.
